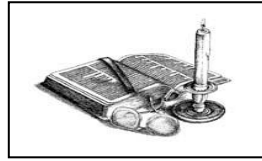

Wednesday Night Bible Study

1st Corinthians chpt 10

Give to Live (pt 2 of 2)

Some have difficulty letting go of what they have to be generous with others. But in doing so they fail to place their faith in the Source of every good gift (**Ecclesiastes 3:13, James 1:25**). God has not been stingy in His generosity (**Romans 8:32**), nor did Jesus keep a tight fist on His glory and riches but became poor so that we might be rich (**Philippians 2:5-7, 2 Corinthians 8:9**).

We are indeed partakers of the divine nature (**2 Peter 1:4**) when we exercise generosity. God loves a cheerful giver (**2 Corinthians 9:7**) and no wonder, as He Himself loves to lavish gifts on those who cannot pay Him back and did nothing to earn them. Jesus encouraged us to invite those to dinner who are poor, maimed, lame, and blind because they cannot repay us, and if we do we will be repaid at the resurrection (**Luke 14:12-14**).

Every act of generosity, even the smallest one, we extend is observed by God Himself. The alms given by a Gentile named Cornelius are noted three times in Acts and were said to have gone up before God's notice (**Acts 10:2,4,31**). Jesus taught that even providing a cup of cold water to a disciple would be recorded and reward reserved (**Matthew 10:42**). Then at the Judgement, those who gave to others in need were recognized by the King as having given their gifts to the Lord Himself (**Matthew 25:40**).

Whatever we clutch on to we will lose as we can carry nothing with us from this world. But if we give, we will live richly, in this life and the one to come.
