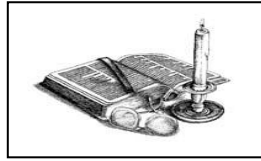

A Simple but Important Message for High School Graduates

I Was recently invited to speak to a graduating class at a local high school. Having spent time as a youth minister, campus minister, preacher, and college professor (plus being a father of four) I had lots of thoughts swirling around in my head. However, my allotted time to speak was five minutes! Five minutes to speak truth to teenagers. What a task!

Here's what I shared with them and I humbly ask that you share it with others. Cling to Jesus! Cling to Jesus! Cling to Jesus!

Before there was ever a Vacation Bible School song called, "The Wise Man Built his House upon the Rock", there was a portion of a sermon by Jesus that talked about it. In [Matthew 7:24-27](#), Jesus said the storms will come so build your house on the Rock. Jesus is the Rock!

Before anyone graduated from high school, the Hebrew writer encouraged a group of truly persecuted Christians to consider Jesus and to look to him. He urged them to "fix your eyes on Jesus"! That message has not changed. He's still the Rock to build your life upon! He's still the One to fix your eyes upon if you hope to navigate life successfully and make it to eternity with your soul intact.

We live in a world that wants nothing more than to drag people away from Jesus. Young people, sadly, leave the faith in droves after high school. The reasons are many but two stand out: 1) Young people lack their own faith. Parents and churches need to train their young people to stay strong and faithful and to develop their own relationship with Jesus; 2) the world and its ways are enticing. We are continually warned about this in Scripture and we need to make sure our young people keep their eyes wide open ([Hebrews 12:1-3](#)).

Young people, whether you attend a Christian college, enter the workforce, or go to the most secular school in the country...cling to Jesus! Whether you are surrounded by believers or surrounded by heathens...cling to Jesus! Whether you attend daily chapel, worship every Sunday, and Bible classes in-between or you live in a far-off place away from family and solid spiritual connections...cling to Jesus!

No one else died for you but Him! No one else cares for you like Him! He is as real as real gets and He is as true as true can be...cling to Him!

Before the first Sunday morning comes around in August or September when you find yourself in a place by yourself...have a plan as to where you will attend worship. Ask your parents, your preacher, your youth minister, or your elders to help you. If they won't or can't help you then send me an email.
